Lazulum

(Lazulum = heaven, sky - medieval Latin, derived from Arabic and Persian; and origin of the name 'lapis lazuli')

the gleam of the kingfisher's wing flares as wild as a flame's fiercest blue

the mirrored sky before us breaks as the arrowed beak cleaves the water

the bird a lightning flash impaling the fish flailing in the stream

we stand stunned nailed to the quivering air

(Lapis lazuli = [bright blue] stone said to come from the heavens/ skies)
